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THE FILM

SYNOPSIS

Ru is inspired by the story of the arrival of Kim Thúy (Tinh) in Quebec. After a dangerous sea crossing and a stay in a Malaysian refugee camp, a young Vietnamese girl named Tinh and her family arrive in Quebec where they begin a new life. Thanks to the warm welcome from all, including their sponsor family, she slowly adapts to her new reality. Tinh will overcome her shyness to learn a new language, discover a new culture and adjust to a new life in Quebec.



The film ru is inspired by the real-life story of Kim Thúy, who at 10 left Vietnam with her family as "boat people" to eventually settle in Quebec. Having exercised multiple careers, including seamstress, interpreter, lawyer and restaranteur, today Kim Thúy is one of Canada's most prolific Canadian authors. Chevalière de l'Ordre national du Québec, she has received numerous awards, including the Governor General's Literary Award and was a finalist for the New Academy Prize in Literature (Alternative Nobel). Published in 2009, ru became an instant bestseller in Quebec and France. The autobiographic tale has been sold worldwide and translated into 31 languages. The English version (translated by Sheila Fischman) was a Giller Prize finalist and won the prestigious Canada Reads competition. Kim Thúy lives and works in Montréal.

At the age of 10, Kim Thúy left Vietnam along with her family as "boat people" to eventually settle in Quebec. With degrees in translation and law, the author has worked as a seamstress, interpreter, lawyer and restaurant owner. Kim Thúy has received several awards, including the 2010 Governor General's Literary Award, and was one of the four finalists for the New Academy Prize in Literature (Alternative Nobel) in 2018. Her books, which have sold over 850,000 copies worldwide, have been translated into 31 languages and sold in 43 countries and territories. Kim Thúy lives in Montréal and devotes her time to writing.

The author's first book, *ru*, published in 2009 by Libre Expression, was an instant success. A bestseller in Quebec and France and translated in 31 languages, *ru* has also won many literary awards, including the prestigious Canadian Governor General's Literary Award 2010, the Grand Prix RTL-Lire 2010 at the Salon du livre de Paris, the Italian Mondello Prize for Multiculturalism 2011 and the Grand Prix littéraire Archambault 2011. *ru* a was also a finalist for the Prix des cinq continents de la francophonie in 2010 and the prestigious Giller Prize 2012 for Best Canadian book. The English adaptation won the Canada Reads battle of the books and was declared "the" Canadian book to read in 2015.

ru comprises three very short intertwined stories which recount the events experienced by the narrator: her birth in Vietnam during the war, her escape with the "boat people," her welcome in a small Quebec town, her studies, her family ties, her autistic child, etc. The author's life is filled with unique, charming people and difficult or bizarre situations approached with the same pleasure. Kim Thúy knows how to play with the reader's feelings perfectly.


